The golfing program has been developed to provide the membership with a variety of competitions which will be both challenging and enjoyable.

The social program is an essential part of the life of Tuggerah Lakes Golf Club. Everyone is encouraged to support these functions.

The regulations and By-laws for the Clubhouse and Course have been developed over many years to ensure that all members can enjoy their membership and that standards of behaviour and dress are maintained at a level expected by all members. These By-laws and regulations are now available to all members on request. It is essential that all members are familiar with these regulations and support their implementation.

Tuggerah Lakes Morning Moaners

All Members of the Tuggerah Lakes Morning Moaners are members of Tuggerah Lakes Golf Club. They have been a part of our golf club for many years. They are entitled to the first 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ hours tee times on most Sunday mornings throughout the year.

Club Regulations

CATERING SERVICES

Catering Services are provided at various times throughout the year. Please see notice board.

MEMBERSHIP FEES

Members are reminded that fees are payable in advance and are therefore due on or before July 1 each year. Any member who has not paid within a period of thirty (30) days from July 1 shall be given fourteen (14) days written notice, after which time they will forfeit all privileges of membership and their name shall be removed from the register of members of the Club.

MEMBERS DETAILS

Members shall notify the General Manager immediately upon a change of personal details. Address, phone & email address.

Clubhouse, Course & Practice Facilities

DRESS REGULATIONS

Members, Lady members and their guests must be suitably attired when on the course and in the clubhouse. Appropriate foot wear must be worn on the golf course and in the Clubhouse.

Work clothes are allowable in the Bottom Bar.

On the course, appropriate golfing attire is required. See dress regulation signage outside the Golf Shop and in the Clubhouse foyer.

Visitors:

Must comply with the dress regulations.

Golfers not conforming to the above dress regulations will not be permitted on the course or practice facilities.

BEHAVIOUR & LANGUAGE

Offensive Behaviour and Language - Members are reminded that behaviour and language within the Clubhouse and Course must be of an appropriate standard.

Staff are required to ask members and guests who are considered intoxicated to leave the Clubhouse and Course.

SERVICE OF ALCOHOL

Junior & Cadets

Junior and Cadet Members may enter the main lounge unaccompanied. Under no circumstances will any Junior or Cadet Member be permitted to enter the poker machine area or within two metres of the main bar for any purpose whatsoever nor will any Junior or Cadet Member be permitted any alcoholic drinks. Juniors and Cadets may purchase drinks at auditorium end of bar only.

Members are warned that any person supplying alcohol or cigarettes to a Junior or Cadet Member will be severely disciplined by the Board of Directors.

No restriction is placed on the use of the dining room but Juniors and Cadets are requested not to use tables set up for dining room service unless they are using the room for that purpose.

Person's under 18 years of age are permitted in the members bar/snooker room. Junior members may use the snooker tables only in the company of a member.

GENERAL

No canvassing for donations etc unless approved by the Management.

Golf Regulations

ETIQUETTE OF THE GAME

1. No one should move, talk, stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
2. No player should play until the group in front is out of range.
3. In the interest of all, players should play without delay.
4. A player who has incurred a penalty should intimate the fact to his opponent or marker as soon as possible.
5. Players while searching for a ball should allow other matches coming up to pass them; they should signal to the players following them to pass, and having given the signal should not continue their play until these players have passed and are out of range.
6. When the result of a hole has been determined, players are requested to immediately leave the green and not re-try their putts or practice putting.
7. All players are requested to carry a sand bucket and to repair all their divots and plug marks on greens.
8. It is the responsibility of the lowest marker in any match to see that the above points are observed.
9. In order to avoid damaging the hole, players and caddies should not stand too close to the hole and should take care during the handling of the flagstick and the removal of a ball from the hole.
The head of a club should not be used to remove a ball from the hole.
10. Players must not take their buggies between the green and a green side bunker

SLOW PLAY

Every effort should be made to eliminate slow play which destroys the pleasure of golf. The following measures are suggested to reduce slow play:

1. Each group must keep their place in the field. They must maintain their position behind the group in front.
2. Players should hit off quickly from the tee.
3. At the tee, the honour should be ignored if a player is not ready to play. Through the green a player should play as soon as they reach their ball if there is no danger to other players.
4. In stableford and par events, players should pick up their ball when they are unable to score a point or half on a hole.
5. During play, only a player, the partner and caddies should search for a ball. If others join the search, the following group of players must be called through immediately.
6. After completing 9 holes, players must not stop at the halfway bar if the next tee is clear. Players must also be ready to tee off as the 10th green clears.
7. A two stroke penalty may apply. Rule 6-7 undue delay – slow play

Conditions of Competition Play

COMPETITION FIELD

If for any reason, the field for any competition comprises less than thirty (30) players the Captain shall determine whether the competition type be altered or the competition be cancelled.

THE STARTER

The Starter, acting on behalf of the Board, will perform all duties laid down by the Board from time to time, and shall act with the full authority of the Board.

All members in the competition are in the hands of the starter and are to start at the discretion of the Starter.

Members are to report to the Starter 15 minutes before their hit off time. In the event of late arrival, 15 minutes before scheduled hit off, a penalty of two strokes on first hole may be imposed by starter. Players are to be on the tee to be ready to tee off at their designated tee time.

TIME SHEETS

Draws for times on Time Sheets are held at 6.00 pm on Monday night for Tuesday and Thursday of the following week and Friday night at 6.00 pm for Saturday and Sunday for the following week.

Members are requested that all players who will be playing are placed on the Time Sheet.

If a Member is unable to play on a particular day they must remove their name from the time sheet as soon as possible. Members failing to cancel their booking will receive a letter and subsequent infringements will be dealt with by the Board.

There will be some draws held on a Public Holiday and none when a function is scheduled. They will be held on Tuesday or Thursday as appropriate.

Bookings and information is now available on the Club Website. www.tlgc.com.au Bookings for Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday can be made on the website on the Tuesday and Saturday following the draw.

SCORECARDS

All scorecards, should be entered on Touch Screens and placed in the designated chute provided, within 15 minutes after completion of the round. It is the player's responsibility to see that it is correctly filled in (handicap and membership number included), signed by marker and countersigned by the player. Failure to do so will lead to disqualification. No alteration may be made on a scorecard after the player has handed it in. The scorecard is the final record for determining results in competitions.

MOBILE PHONES

The use of mobile or portable phones by a competitor or his caddie whilst on the golf course, during an event is regarded as distracting and offending to other players. If a competitor or his caddie is in possession of a mobile or portable phone they must have them turned off. Any player or caddie who uses a mobile or portable phone during their round will be dealt with under rule 33-7/8.

ANIMALS

No animals to accompany those playing

COUNT BACK

9 Hole Competition

Last six holes, last three, hole by hole from 9th.

18 Hole Competition

The best score for the last nine holes shall be used. If there is a tie, the last six holes shall be used and, if still tied, then the last 3 holes shall be used, if still tied then hole by hole scores shall be taken from the 18th hole.

27 Hole Competition

18 hole card to be used, if there is a tie, countback as in 18 holes.

36, 54 and 72 Hole Competition

The last 18 holes shall be used if there is a tie, the count back as in 18 hole events shall be used.

NOTE : The best score for the last six holes shall be applied in handicap events and a penalty applicable under Rule 3-5 (General Penalty) shall be ignored as far as the count back is applied.

Monthly Medals

Any ties in Monthly Medals will be played off over 18 holes on the next Medal Round. The Playoff will be contested using the players current handicaps.

HANDICAPS

All Members single competitions shall be conducted in three grades as follows

A Grade 0-12

B Grade 13-18

C Grade 19-36 C1 19-24 C2 25-36 (when applicable)

Each Member is responsible for ascertaining his current handicap

and recording same on his score card. If in doubt (after checking with the computer) reference should be made to the General Manager, Handicap Manager or Office Staff.

To retain an Australian handicap a Member must have, as at January 1 each year, at least three cards during the preceding 12 months, otherwise his handicap will lapse until such time as he brings the number up to three.

Handicaps are computerised. Members can receive a copy of their handicap on request from the office.

SELECTED LOCAL RULES

See notice board outside Golf Shop for complete list of local rules.

Out of Bounds is defined by:

- Boundary fences – no free relief
- Boundary posts marked white with black tops – no free relief
- Road curbs marked with white and black

These areas include the car park, Shelly Beach Road and Club access roads.

A ball which crosses a line of boundary markers along Shelly Beach Road or an access road is out of bounds even if it comes to rest on another part of the course.

Marker Stakes

Marker stakes must be treated as immovable obstructions.

Yellow : Define water hazards, **Red** : Lateral water hazard, **White** : Ground under repair, **White & Green** : Ground under repair protected garden.

Immovable Obstructions

- Clubhouse, maintenance and cart shed, pump house near 3rd green.
- Rocks placed on the course including those along Shelly Beach Road.
- Tagged trees and tree guards. (Relief must be taken.)
- Distance markers.
- Defined pathways and artificial surfaces. A player is also entitled to relief from artificial surface material that has spread or been applied to areas beyond defined paths, but not grass clippings or corings, unless piled for removal as per Rule 25.
- Safety Screens behind 10th green, along 12th boundary fence and on 9th tee.

Distance Markers

All distance markers on sprinkler heads and (100, 150, 200m markers) are to the centre of the green

Distance Devices - devices that measure distance only may be used- Refer Appendix 1 Part B-9

G.U.R.

- (a) Areas defined by white stakes or lines – white/green stakes.
- (b) Wheel tracks through the green, (not golfing equipment.)
- (c) All cultivated gardens are defined by white stakes with green top and relief must be taken.
- (d) Players taking relief from G.U.R. areas adjacent to the 18th and 9th green may use the nearest drop zone.

Areas covered by wood chips, other than constructed paths with borders, are declared integral parts of the course unless marked as GUR. A ball lying in such an area must be played as it lies or declared unplayable.

Drop Zones (9th /18th Holes)

May be used when taking relief (without penalty) from Clubhouse and adjacent gardens and pathways.

Relief must be taken from the Practice Putting Green in front of Clubhouse (may use drop zone)

Fixed Sprinkler Heads

All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24.2. In addition if such an obstruction on or within two club lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play, the player may obtain relief, without penalty as follows :

If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club lengths of the intervening hazard, it may be lifted cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which

- (a) is not nearer the hole
- (b) avoids such intervention
- (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

Preferred Lies

When in operation may only be taken on defined fairways. The ball must be marked, lifted cleaned and placed on the fairway within 15.2 cm (6 inches) from where the ball lay, but not nearer the hole. (Refer Appendix 1-4C

Embedded Ball- When in operation

A ball embedded in it's own pitch – mark in the ground in any closely mown area through the green may be lifted , cleaned and dropped, without penalty, as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.

Closely mown area “means any area of the course including paths through the rough, cut to fairway height or less”. RULE 25:2

Aeration Holes

If a ball comes to rest in an aeration hole on the putting green of the

hole being played, the player may lift, clean and place the ball at the nearest spot not nearer the hole that avoids such situation.

TEE MARKERS

- Red** – LGU, WGNSW
- Yellow** – Public and Social Clubs
- White** – Members
- Blue** – Championship

CARE OF THE COURSE

1. Avoid walking up the face of bunkers – always leave a bunker by the way you enter it and smooth out your foot marks with the rakes provided for this purpose - leave rakes outside bunkers after use.
2. Do not practice off tees or fairways - use the defined practice area.
3. Use care in replacing the flagstick so that the hole will not be damaged.
4. Buggies must not be wheeled across the green, through bunkers or on the tees.
5. Replace all divots and repair your lob marks on the green.
6. Receptacle bins are provided to assist in maintaining tidy appearance. PLEASE USE.
7. Fill all divots with sand. Buckets are on 1st and 10th tees and sand is provided on all tees.

Trophies All trophy vouchers are placed on the member's house account.

NOTE: Small fields of less than 70 players in the field may mean there is a reduction in trophies being awarded.

COMPETITIONS

Two ball best ball

Note: in a 2BBB stroke event, the better ball scores of partners, according to the stroke index and players stroke handicap, is recorded eg. a player plays off 14 handicap and his stroke score on each hole is adjusted accordingly to the hole index, so that the player receives a stroke on holes indexed to 14. The gross score less a stroke is recorded. A member playing in a mixed event may also play in the Members' Singles Event.

Medley Competition

Play as a 2BBB – either par or stableford but – 2 Men or 2 Ladies or a Man and a Lady may pair. Men play on their stroke HCP. Ladies play on their stroke index

Canadian Foursomes

Each player plays a tee shot before choosing the ball to play. Each player then plays alternative stroke until holed out.

NOTE: penalty strokes do not affect the order of rotation.

American Foursomes

Each player plays a tee shot; each player then plays his partner's ball before choosing the ball to hit. Each player then plays alternative strokes until holed out.

NOTE: Penalty strokes do not affect the order of rotation.

2-Stroke Canadian Foursomes

Each player plays 2 strokes with own ball before choosing the ball to play. Each player then plays alternative strokes until holed out.

NOTE: Penalty strokes do not affect the order of rotation.

Ambrose

Each player tees off. One ball chosen then each player plays within club length and continues until holed out. On the putting green place ball within one putter head.
